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ABSTRACT – Geographical Information Systems (GIS) are powerful tools of spatial data visualization and analysis. Their use can support Development Cooperation projects, providing new spatial analysis tools and innovative participatory methods. On the other hand, they can lead to the exclusion of some communities, due to digital divide and a Western-oriented approach to spatial representation.
